The [Pew Research Internet Project](#) reports these findings about teachers:

- 84% use the Internet weekly to find content that will engage students
- 80% use the Internet weekly to find material to help create lesson plans
- 92% say the Internet has had a major impact on their teaching with increased access to content, resources, and materials
- Smartphone use to access the Internet is more than double the rate of the general adult population

"More than half the staff at Lesson Planet has actually taught K-12, so we get what it's like to always be thinking about your work," Gibson added. "You can find and save lessons from your phone if you have an idea while you're running errands."

"I was able to find and modify plans while I had to be out of the classroom, a big help as I was away from my other resources," noted Lesson Planet member Theresa Q. from Montana.
